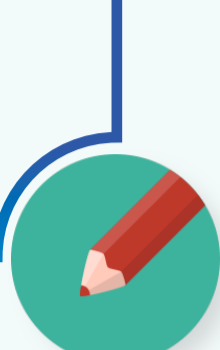

Assign students the 3.5-hour exam on paper or through our online testing environment (desktop or tablet)

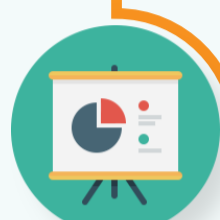
8 alternating SAT and ACT sections give students first-hand exposure to each exam, which they might not otherwise get in school

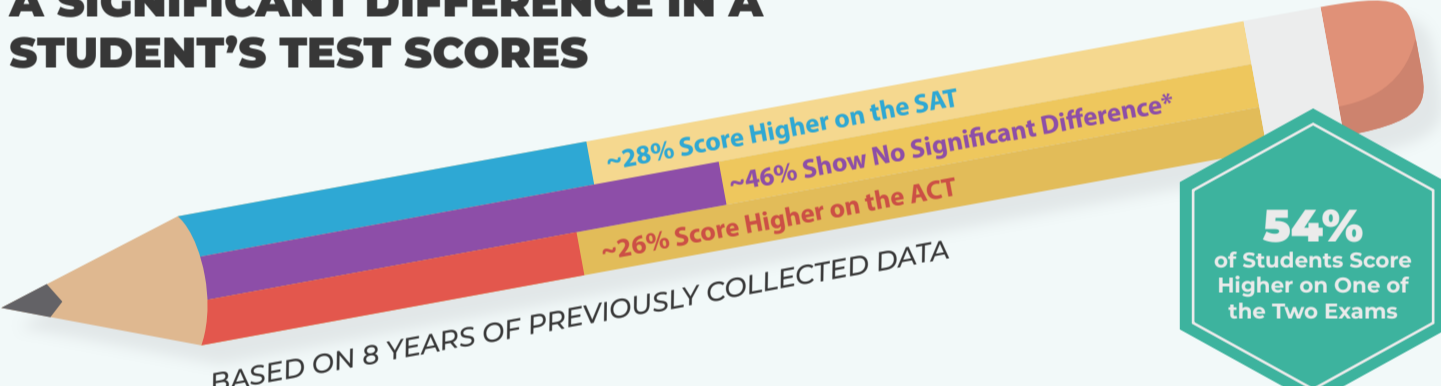

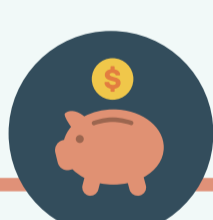

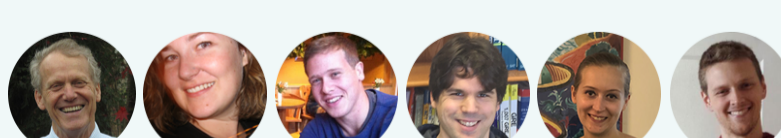

Development & Accuracy

The topics and concepts on The SAT/ACT Diagnostic were determined by counting the occurrence of each topic over 50 actual exams, and proportionally allotting those concepts to problems on The Diagnostic. Our exam is calibrated on an ongoing basis to ensure the most accurate results. The results are analyzed for balance, and sections are tested against actual SAT and ACT exams to further ensure accuracy. The amount of time allotted to read and complete the problems on each section is proportional to the amount of time students are given on both the ACT and the SAT.
